

LEGAL NOTICE

If Your Credit Or Debit Card Was Used To Make a Purchase At www.filtersfast.com Between July 15, 2019 And July 20, 2020, You May Be Entitled To Receive Benefits From, And Your Rights May Be Affected By, A Class Action Settlement.

A federal court authorized this notice. This is not a solicitation from a lawyer.

A proposed Settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit involving Filters Fast, LLC ("Filters Fast"). The Settlement resolves litigation over a cybersecurity incident involving code that was inserted into Filters Fast's website by hacker(s) that was capable of collecting Payment Card data from Filters Fast's checkout pages (the "Incident"). The Parties have agreed to settle the Action in its entirety, without any admission of liability by Filters Fast, pursuant to the terms of a written Settlement Agreement. The case is known as *Sanger Powers, et al., v. Filters Fast, LLC*, Case No. 3:20-cv-00982 (W.D. Wis.).

Who's included in the Settlement Class? The proposed Settlement Class includes all United States residents whose payment card was used to make a purchase on the Filters Fast website at www.filtersfast.com at any time from July 15, 2019 to July 10, 2020.

Who's excluded from the Settlement Class? The judges presiding over this matter, any members of judicial staff, the officers and directors of Filters Fast, and persons who timely and validly request exclusion from the Settlement Class.

What benefits does the Settlement provide? All Settlement Class Members who submit a valid, complete, and timely Claim using the Claim Form, and are eligible to select one of the following Tiers:

Tier 1: Settlement Class Members who attest that they used one or more of their payment cards at the Filters Fast website to make a purchase during the Settlement Class Period, and who provide reasonable proof of unreimbursed out-of-pocket expenses or losses in connection with a fraudulent transaction incurred on the subject payment card, will be entitled to cash payments equal to their out-of-pocket expenses or losses up to \$750, subject to the terms of the Settlement Agreement. The submitted evidence must show the loss is an actual, documented, and unreimbursed monetary loss; the loss was more likely than not caused by the Incident; the loss occurred after the Settlement Class Member used the Payment Card on the Filters Fast website; the Settlement Class Member made reasonable efforts to avoid, or seek reimbursement for, the loss, including but not limited to exhaustion of all available credit monitoring insurance and identity theft insurance.

Tier 2: Settlement Class Members who attest that they used one or more of their Payment Cards at the Filters Fast website to make a purchase during the Settlement Class Period, who submit reasonable proof of a subsequent fraudulent charge on the Payment Card that was more likely than not caused by the Incident, and who attest to the time they spent addressing the fraudulent transaction or monitoring their account as a result of the Incident, will be entitled to cash payments equal to \$15 per hour of time spent addressing the fraudulent transaction or monitoring their account as a result of the Incident up to a maximum of four hours.

Tier 3: Settlement Class Members who attest that they used one or more of their payment cards at the Filters Fast website to make a purchase during the Settlement Class Period shall be entitled to receive up to \$25. Tier 3 payments shall be made up to a total of \$175,000 (the “Tier 3 Amount”). If the total amount of Approved Claims under this Tier 3 exceeds the Tier 3 Amount, then each approved Tier 3 claim shall be calculated on a pro rata basis (by taking the Tier 3 Amount divided by the number of Tier 3 Approved Claims), such that the total aggregate payment made under Tier 3 does not exceed \$175,000.

Business Practice Changes

In addition to the Settlement benefits described above, Filters Fast has taken numerous measures to further enhance the security of its customers’ data.

Credit Monitoring

All Settlement Class Members who submit a valid and timely Claim Form and who did not previously enroll in the 12 months of ID Experts service offered by Filters Fast are eligible to receive 24 months of 1-bureau credit monitoring provided by ID Experts paid for by Filters Fast. Settlement Class Members who previously received and enrolled in the 12 months of ID Experts service offered by Filters Fast are eligible to receive an additional 12 months of 1-bureau credit monitoring provided by ID Experts paid for by Filters Fast.

How do I receive Settlement benefits? In order to receive benefits under this Settlement, Settlement Class Members should complete and submit a Claim Form to the Settlement Administrator. To submit a Claim Form online, please visit **www.FFSettlement.com**. The deadline for submitting Claim Forms is **June 3, 2022** if submitted online, or it must be postmarked by **June 3, 2022** if submitted by U.S mail to the Settlement Administrator at: FF Settlement Administrator, FF Settlement Administrator, Sanger Powers v. Who represents me? The Court appointed William B. Federman of Federman & Sherwood and David K. Lietz of Milberg Coleman Bryson Phillips Grossman PLLC as Class Counsel to represent the Settlement Class. You will not be charged for these lawyers. If you want to be represented by your own lawyer, you may hire one at your own expense.

Your options. If you are included in the Settlement Class and do not submit a Claim Form, your rights will be affected and you may not receive any benefits from this Settlement. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself from the Settlement by **June 3, 2022** by following the instructions in the detailed Long Form Notice available on the

documents section of the website, www.FFSettlement.com or you won't be able to sue, or continue to sue, Filters Fast about the legal claims in this case. If you do not exclude yourself from the Settlement, you may object to it by **June 3, 2022** by following the instructions in the detailed Long Form Notice available on the documents section of the website, www.FFSettlement.com. The Final Approval Hearing. The Court will hold a hearing on **July 22, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. CST** via videoconference to consider whether to approve the Settlement, award Class Counsel Attorneys' Fees and Expenses up to \$320,000, and award the five Class Representatives up to \$2,500 each for their service.
